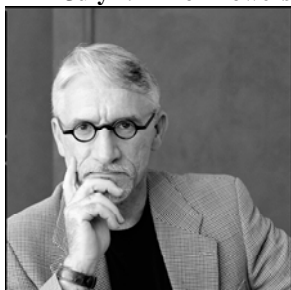

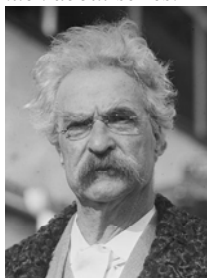

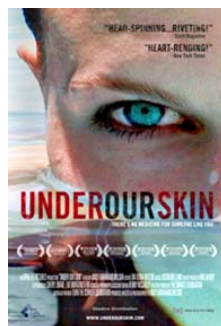
**Classic Children's Books: Tuesday, July 13 (*Through the Looking Glass*) & July 27 (*Peter Pan*), 12-1:15p.m.**
