

Using Listen Up! Vermont ebooks on your iPad

Ebooks from the Listen Up! Vermont Collection can be read on an Apple iPad. Cardholders can borrow up to 3 ebooks or downloadable audiobooks at one time from the Listen Up! Vermont collection and may choose a lending period of 1 or 2 weeks for each title. And it's not necessary to return items: ebooks simply expire after the due date. There is no late fee! Returning books early, however, will immediately free up the cardholder's account to borrow additional titles.

To borrow an ebook you will need to:

- Install the latest version of the Overdrive Media Console (available at the iTunes store) on your iPad. You will need your iTunes password for this.
- Set up an Adobe ID to authorize the Overdrive Media Console.

Once you have all of the above, follow these steps:

1. On your iPad, open the Overdrive Media Console
2. Authorize the Overdrive Media Console with your Adobe ID (you will be prompted to create an Adobe ID if you haven't already)
3. Click on the Get Books button in the upper right corner
4. Click on the **Add a Library +** button
5. Type **www.listenupvermont.org** and click search
6. Select Ilsley Public Library from the list
7. On the GMLC (Green Mountain Library Consortium) webpage, click on the Login button on the right side
8. Select Ilsley Public Library from the list
9. Click on the **Ilsley Public Library users, please click here to sign into this system** link
10. Type in your library card number and click on the Login button
11. Click on the browse button and select browse all adobe EPUB eBook Titles.
12. Select a title that is available by clicking on the **add to basket** button
13. Click on the **Proceed to Checkout** button
14. Click on the Download button
