



Get books on your Nook Color or Tablet: Overdrive Media Player App on Android devices

1. On your Android device, go to listenupvermont.org using your mobile browser.
2. Click the icon on the bottom of the page to get the free **Overdrive Media Console App**.
3. Touch **Install**, and follow prompts. Open **OverDrive Media Console** when complete.
4. If you already have an Adobe ID and password, enter it to authorize the app on your NOOK. If not, please read directions below.

Creating an Adobe ID and Password:

Touch the **Get a free Adobe ID** button, and the Adobe site will open. Touch on **Sign In** on the upper right. Touch **Create an Adobe Account**. You will be asked to supply some information in the required fields. This is a secure site BUT Adobe is not affiliated with Rockingham Library. Touch **Continue** at the bottom of the page. Exit browser, and open **OverDrive Media Console**.

5. Inside the OverDrive App, tap **Get Books**.
6. Tap **Add a Library** and search for the "Ilsley Public Library" and select it. Add it to your list by tapping the star next to the name.
7. Tap **Listen Up! Vermont** from the "Get Books" list to go to the site.
8. On the Listen Up! Vermont website, tap **Login** on the menu bar at the top of the page.
9. Select **Ilsley Public Library** from the list and enter your 14-digit library card number on the next page.
10. Browse or search for eBook and/or audiobook titles. EPUB, MP3, and PDF are compatible formats with your device.

Librarian Search Tips:

Titles that say **Add to Basket** are available immediately. Titles that say **Join Waiting List** are checked out. If you join the waiting list you will receive an email when the title is available. You can limit your search to titles **Available Now**.

11. Once you have selected an available title, tap **Add to Basket**. You may **Continue Browsing** to add up to 2 more titles.
12. Once you have your selection(s) in your basket, tap **Proceed to Checkout**.
13. Choose a 7- or 14-day lending period. Tap **Confirm Checkout**.
14. Tap **Download**.
15. The item will now be available in the "Bookshelf" portion of the Overdrive app.
