


Creating a Facebook Account


Facebook is a great tool for staying in contact with friends who you wouldn't ordinarily be able to talk to regularly. In order to create a Facebook account, you must already have an email address.

- 1) Travel to www.facebook.com and find the area titled "Sign Up," and fill in the necessary information:

- 2) Facebook will ask whether you would like to send friend requests to Facebook members who are also in your email contact list. You can allow this by pressing the "Find Friends" button, or you can go to the "Skip this step" link found on the bottom of the right-hand side of the webpage:
