Using ebooks on your Kindle*

Books from the Listen Up Vermont Collection can be read on an Amazon Kindle. Ilsley Library cardholders can borrow up to 3 ebooks or downloadable audiobooks at one time from the Listen Up! Vermont collection and may choose a lending period of 1 or 2 weeks for each title. And it's not necessary to return items: ebooks simply expire after the due date. There is no late fee! Returning books early, however, will immediately free up the cardholder's account to borrow additional titles.

On a computer:

- 1. In your Web browser (such as Internet Explorer, Mozilla Firefox, etc.) open a new tab, sign into your Amazon.com account.
- 2. In a separate browser tab, visit the library's ebook collection, www.listenupvermont.org
- 3. Sign in to your account by selecting Ilsley Public Library from the list of libraries and entering your library number (on the back of your library card).
- 4. Check out an ebook by click on the **Borrow** button.
- 5. Click on the download button and select the Kindle format, then **Confirm & Download**.
- 6. You will be redirected to the Amazon website. Click the **Get library book** button. (If you haven't signed in already, you will need to enter your Amazon username and password.)
- 7. Choose a Kindle device as your "Deliver to" destination, and then click on **Get library book**.

On your Kindle:

- 8. Turn on your Kindle and make sure your wireless *Wi-Fi* service is active (Public Library books cannot be downloaded over the 3G network).
- 9. Sync your device or app to download the book.
- 10. If your Kindle is not Wi-Fi capable or you do not have an active Wi-Fi connection, read Amazon's instructions for transferring files via USB.

Manage public library books:

- Visit the Amazon.com website, sign in, and click on Manage your Content and Devices
- Use the **Actions...** dropdown menu to the right of each title to:
 - Deliver the title to a device
 - Download & transfer via USB
 - Return the book
 - Delete from library (for expired titles)
