

## Using Listen Up! Vermont ebooks & MP3 audiobooks on your Kindle Fire

On the Green Mountain Library Consortium (GMLC) Listen Up! Vermont Collection (<http://listenupvermont.org>), you can borrow both ePUB ebooks and MP3 audiobooks to use on your Kindle Fire.

- To use Overdrive EPUB books, install the latest version of the Overdrive Media Console (available on the Amazon website) on your Kindle.
- Open the OverDrive app and follow the prompts to create an OverDrive account and log in.
- If you're using a first generation Kindle Fire, you'll need to authorize your device with an Adobe ID to download EPUB eBooks. It's a one-time, free process that takes just moments to complete. Set up an Adobe ID to authorize the Overdrive Media Console on your Kindle. To obtain an Adobe ID, browse to <https://www.adobe.com/account/sign-in.adobedotcom.html>

Once you have all of the above, you can download Adobe EPUB books as follows:

1. In the OverDrive app, find your library's OverDrive website. On most Kindle Fires, you can do this by swiping from left to right to open the **Home** menu, then tapping **Add a library**. On first generation Kindle Fires, tap the **Add a library** icon (or, if you don't have this icon, go to **Menu > Get Books**).
2. Enter the Middlebury's zip code to search for Ilsley Library.
3. Select Ilsley Public Library from the list.
4. On the Listen Up Vermont webpage ([listenupvermont.org](http://listenupvermont.org)), click on the Login button on the right side.
5. Select Ilsley Public Library from the list
6. Click on the **Ilsley Public Library users, please click here to sign into this system** link
7. Type in your Ilsley library card number and click on the Login button.
8. Select an Adobe EPUB title to borrow and click on **Borrow**.
9. Click on the **Download** button, select a format and then **Confirm & Download**.
10. Select EPUB eBook or MP3 audiobook to download and add the title to your app bookshelf.

Ilsley Library cardholders can borrow up to 3 ebooks or downloadable audiobooks at one time from the Listen Up! Vermont collection and may choose a lending period of 1 or 2 weeks for each title. It's not necessary to return items: ebooks simply expire after the due date. There is no late fee! Returning books early, however, will immediately free up the cardholder's account to borrow additional titles.
