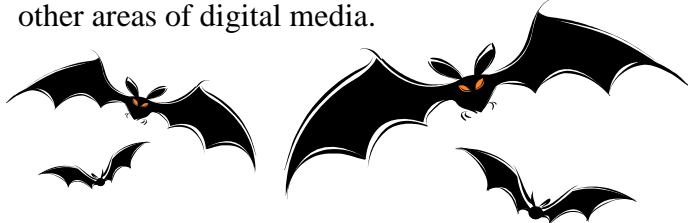
#### Youth Media Lab
