




**Rituals of separation : a South Korean memoir of identity and belonging**

Come hear Elizabeth read from her first book, *Rituals of Separation*, a love song to a cross-cultural childhood and an exploration of issues of belonging, loss, and cultural identity. Elizabeth will discuss the impact of growing up in Korea at a pivotal juncture in that country's history, when South Korea was still recovering from a horrific war that divided the nation into two, industrializing at a rapid pace, and seeing the burgeoning of a democracy movement that would eventually lead to the toppling of a line of dictators.
