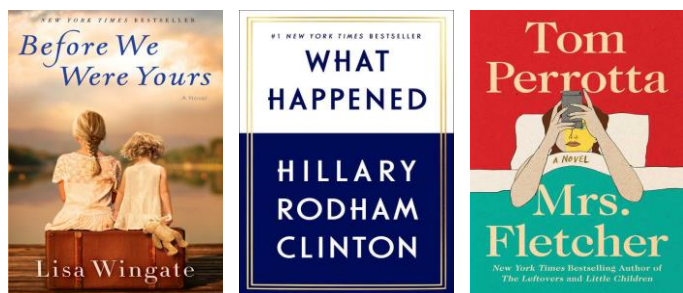
**Hunter access seminar for Vermont landowners
